



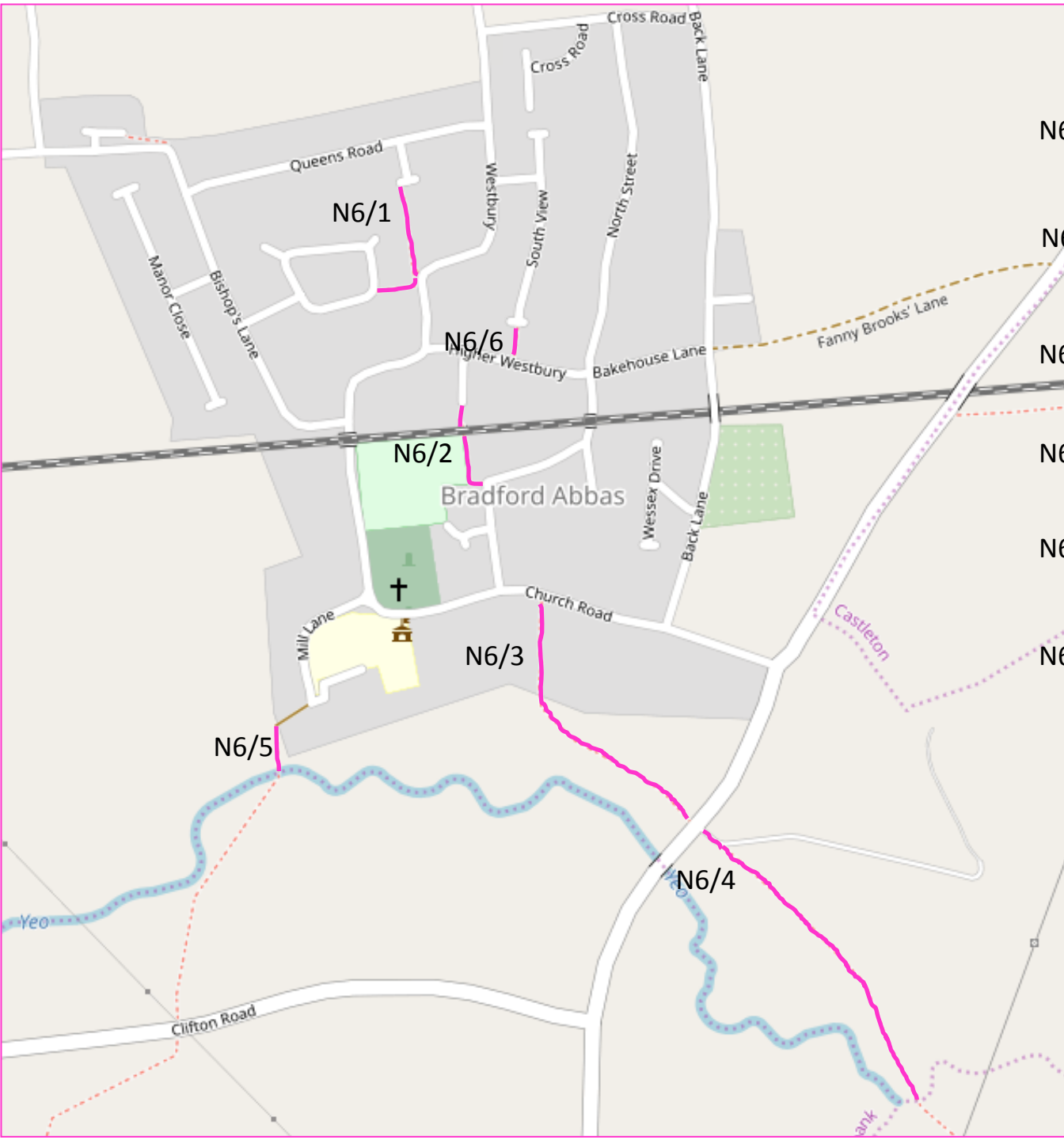

- N6/2 - Higher Westbury to Churchwell Street
- N6/3 - Church Road to Smith's Bridge
- N6/4 - Mill Farm to Foot Bridge
- N6/5 - Mill Lane to River Yeo
- N6/6 - South View to Higher Westbury

N6/4 - Smith's Bridge (Mill Farm) to River Yeo Footbridge

As you can see from the photos, every single footpath runs adjacent to the properties of residents, who occupy their homes permanently, and see far greater foot fall than the East Farm path ever would.

No one has ever complained to the Parish Council about people using the footpaths or about any loss of privacy.

Living in the beautiful Dorset countryside, we can all enjoy the health benefits from taking walks around the village.

For more years than anyone can remember, we have been able to walk up Old Compton Road, across East Farm Lane, down onto Underdown Hollow and back into the village.

Again, none of the residents of either Coombe Cottages or East Farm has ever complained to the Parish Council about people using the lane or about any loss of privacy.

Access to footpaths and relatively safe roadways with very little vehicular traffic encourages many villagers to venture out, as much for the chance to 'bump into' friends and neighbours for a chat and social contact. This is hugely beneficial to lonely, elderly residents and gives everyone an opportunity to make new friends and acquaintances.

Every footpath and permissive right of way is a valuable asset to the whole community.

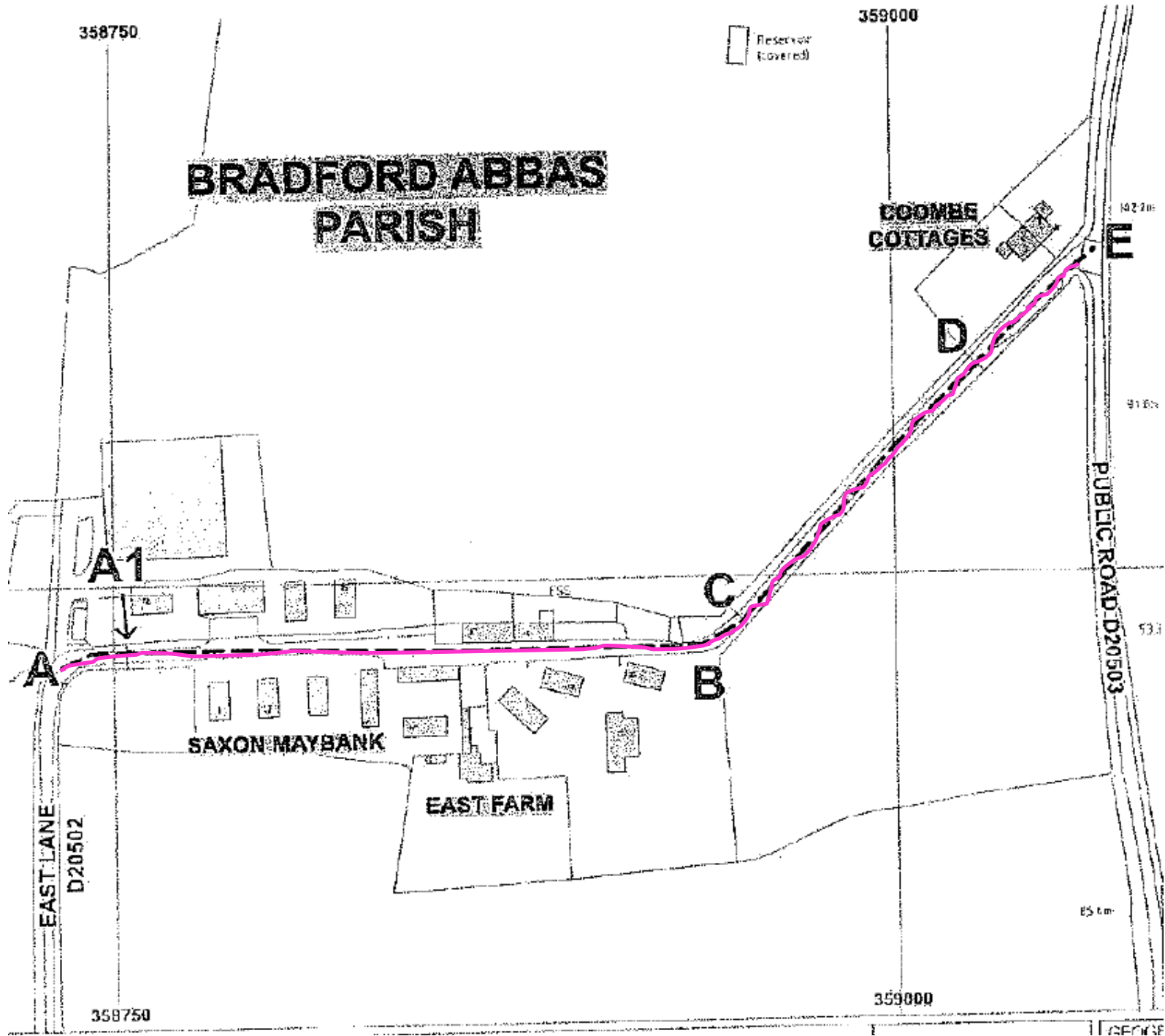
