Climate Change Action: The Parish Council found several dead elm trees in the Westbury boundary hedge of the playing field. It was decided to source disease resistant elm trees. Six were placed on order. The three larger of the trees were planted in the playing field on the Westbury boundary and one at the bottom of Fannybrook's Lane. We also received five small elm trees "free of charge" and these with the other two

were offered to Manor Farm as the Loxton family have commenced a substantial tree planting programme.
